REMINDERS:

1. Please sign the **attendance sheet**. Attendance is a sign of your desire to be confirmed. The expectations for confirmation are that candidates will participate in the group sessions, classes, commitment ceremony, retreat, service project and reconciliation/rehearsal. 2. **Baptismal Information forms** - must be filled out and returned by December 5th. If you were NOT baptized at St. Pius X Parish, you also have to get a copy of your Baptism certificate from the parish in which you were Baptized and return it to us. They may fax it to us at 894-8899.
3. Bring a 2" X 3" **wallet-size photo** for inclusion on the Confirmation banner.
4. **Sponsors:** must be confirmed Catholics. Godparents are recommended as sponsors (1 is required may have 2). Spiritual aide/guide, who will remain close to the candidate.
5. **Community service:** is an important aspect of living our Catholic Christian Faith. Putting our faith into action. This year we will have candidates participate in ThinkFast as we learn about the needs of others and do a small bit in helping out those in need.
